



Madagascar Strategic Measures in Respond to the Pandemic

- 
- Adoption of the decree N° 2020-359 of March 21, 2020 proclaiming the sanitary emergency all over the Republic
 - Implementation of the COVID-19 Operational Command Center on March 23, 2020

Key center of operational coordination of different measures taken and applied to control the spread of coronavirus in Madagascar that serves as the epicenter of information for decision-making. This center is run by the Minister of Interior and decentralization and the Minister of Public Health as the Vice-President




- **Resources Mobilized to Fight against COVID-19 pandemic in Madagascar:**

- *Budget Allocations*
- *Subsidies from public institutions*
- *Donations and aids in cash*
- *Supports of the Technical and Financial Partners (in kind and cash) in accordance with financing agreements)*
- *Donations from Foundations, associations and private sectors*

- **Expenditures Dedicated to the Fight against COVID-19 in Madagascar :**

- *Expenditures incurred, as a preventive, corrective or compensation measure in immediate response against the pandemic*
- *Specific expenditures from institutions or Sectoral Departments for the same objectives*

Management of Public Procurement during the Pandemic in Madagascar

- To answer urgent emergencies, procurements are regulated by the Public Procurement Code

Application of direct procurement procedures, facilitation and alleviation at the level of the Computerized Public Procurement Management System (SIGMP) and at the control level

- Issuing of a notice by the Ministry of Economy and Finances on the suspension of all deadlines pertaining to public procurement in the emergency sanitary situation related to the fight against the spread of COVID-19

In order to suspend market procedures that can wait until the end of the emergency state

- Adoption of the decree on the creation of the « Fonds de riposte à la pandémie Covid-19 » (funds in response to the fight against COVID-19)

The aforementioned funds are dedicated to the financing of actions undertaken in the frame of fighting against COVID-19. Its application decree stipulates world good practices, especially the reporting of expenditures in COVID-19:

Conclusion

- 
- In terms of public procurement management, Madagascar has not encountered loads of difficulties after the:
 - *Implementation of the COVID-19 Operational Command Center (CCO) as expenditures' control body*
 - *Derogation for ministry departments in charge of the fight against COVID-19 (Health, Security, Army, Prison Agency, Commerce...) to proceed with Direct Procurements without consideration of the amounts but under the supervision of the CCO.*
