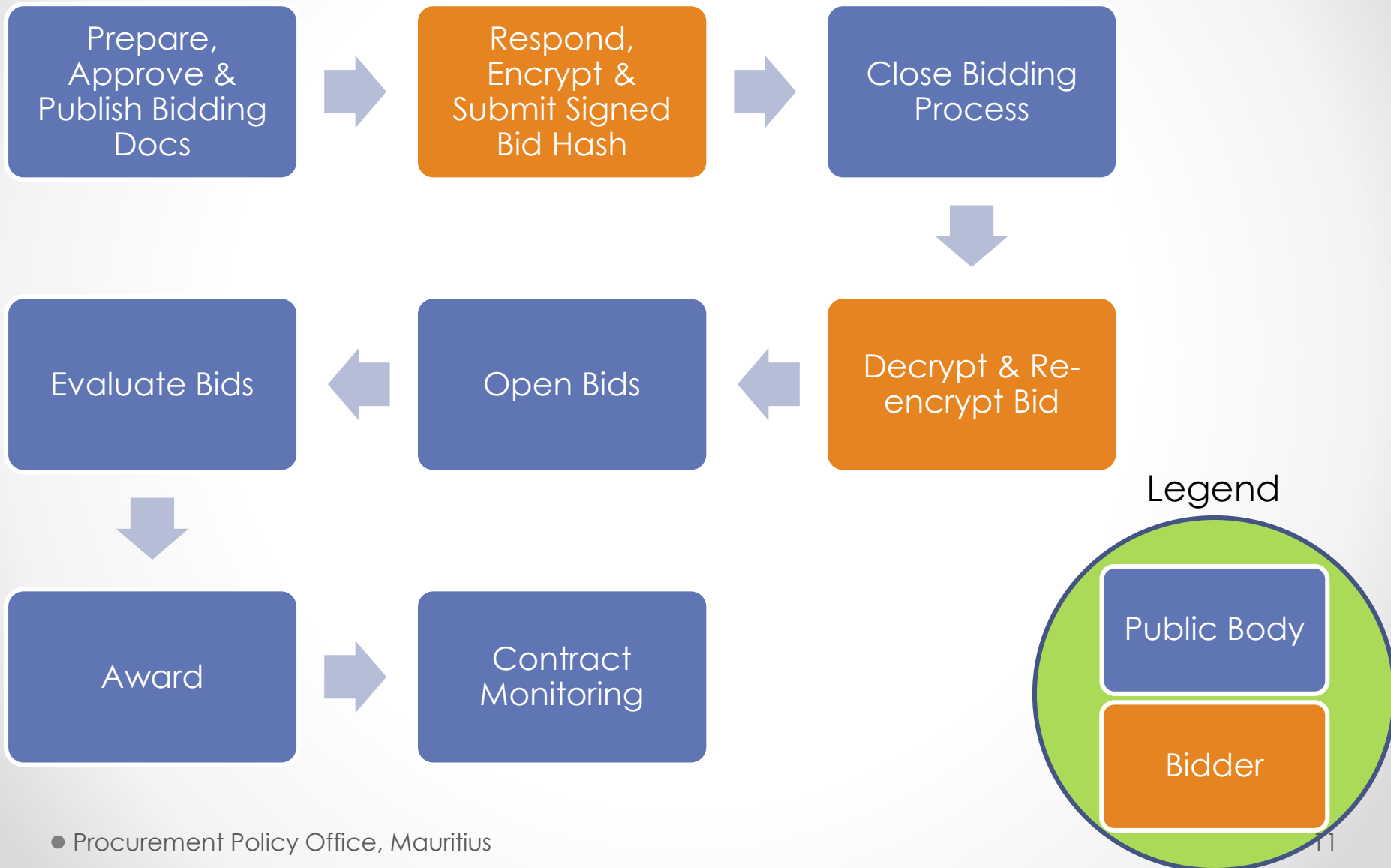

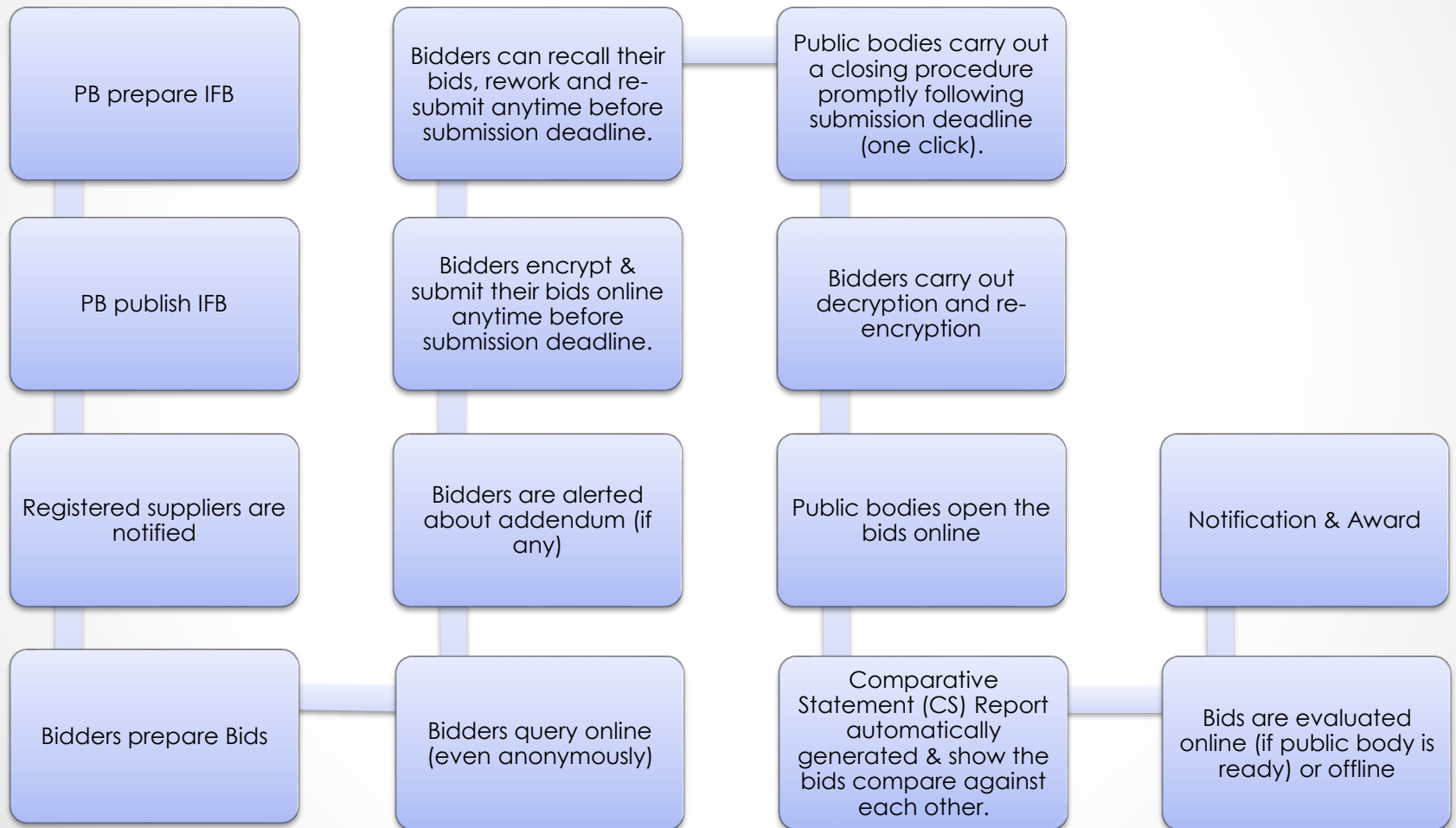

## Procurement Transformation Index (PTI)

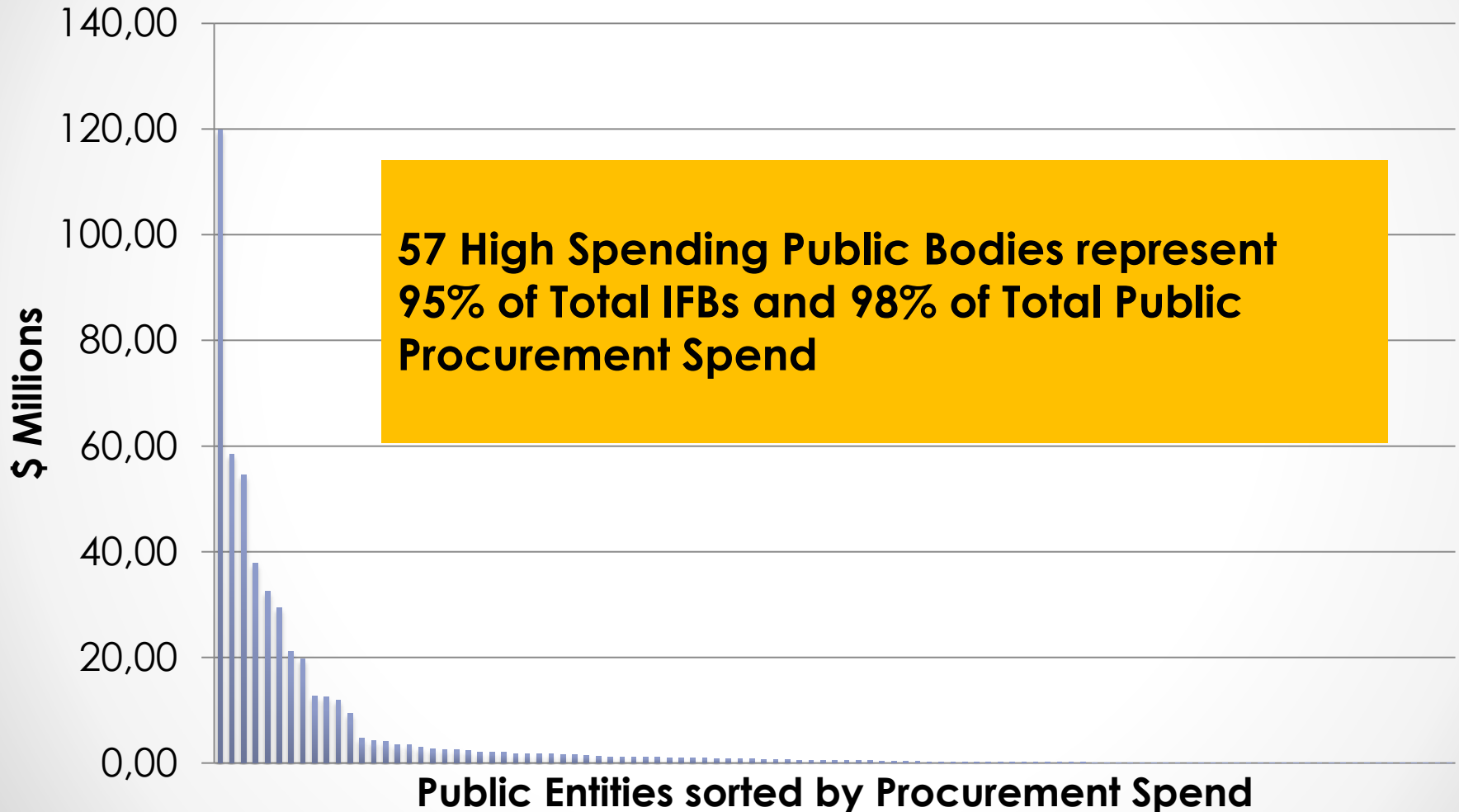


***PTI = Number of procurements processed by the Public Body on e-PS***

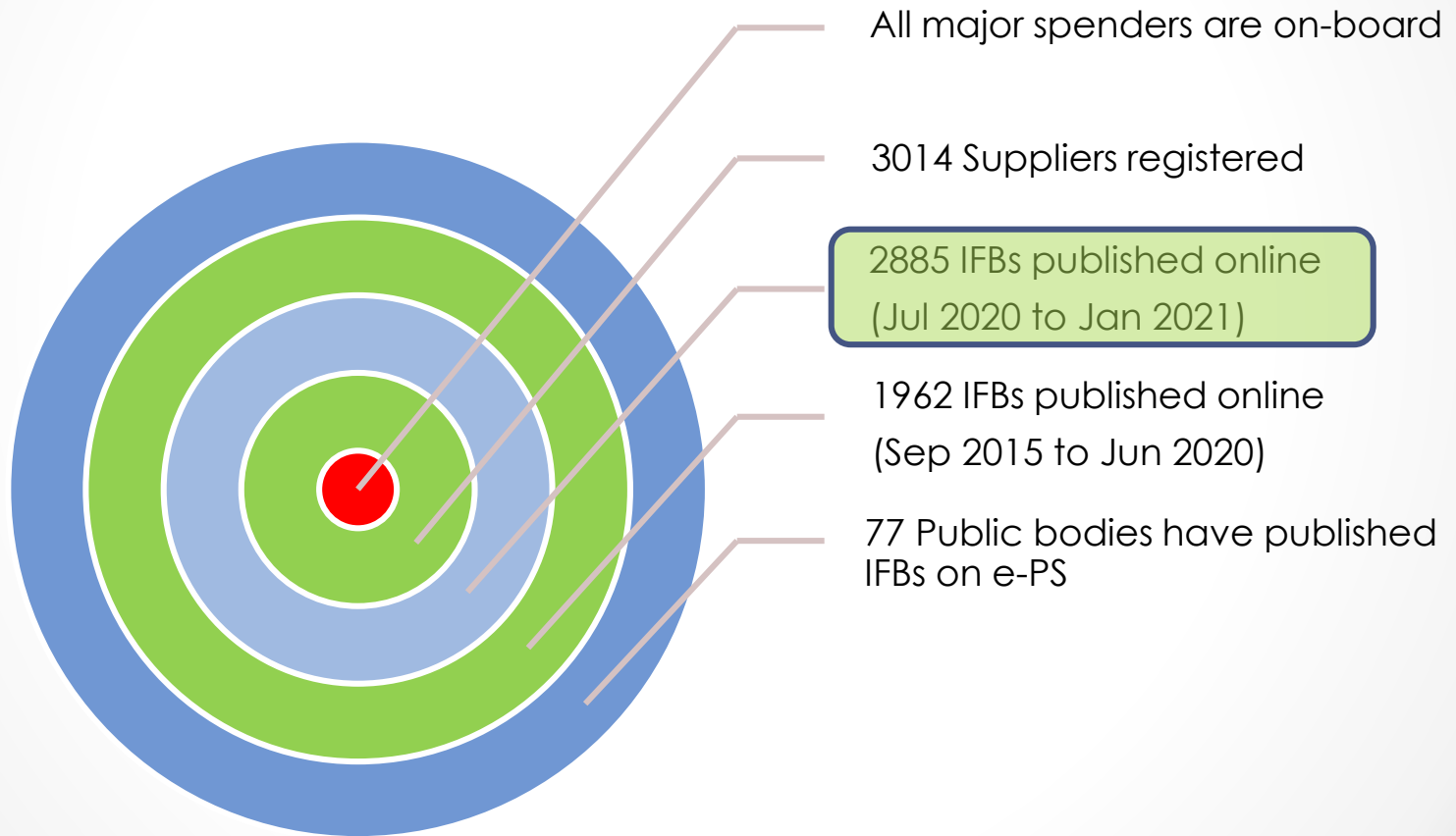
(a) The Mauritius Revenue Authority will regulate fees charged by freight forwarders for Groupage cargo.

## B.6. Improving Public Procurement

With a view to improving public procurement and bringing efficiency in public spending, -

- (a) all public procurement exercises will have to be mandatorily carried out through the e-Procurement System. In the first instance, as from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020, 55 Public Bodies listed at Appendix II will have to undertake all procurement exercises on the e-Procurement System. The remaining Public Bodies will have up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 to fully shift on the e-Procurement System;
