

Towards the Profession of "Public Procurement Specialist" ?





Main recommendations

• Establish "Public Buyer" profession in order to consider public procurement as technical profession instead of an administrative one.

• Distinguish the term "Public Buyer" from procurement that is conferred to a unit in charge of procurement within the procurement entity (Public Buyer)

• Establish a particular status for public procurement specialists.

Main recommendations

• The setting up of a **national accreditation/certification** in collaboration with the public university compulsory for all public agents involved in the process of public procurement and its execution.

• Establish a **transverse module dedicated to public procurement** within the University of Tunisia in the curricula concerning public procurement (engineering schools, trade schools, management schools and institutes, law and economic science schools, etc.)


• Reinforce the **master's degree in "Public Procurement Governance**" by a technical and financial support.



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

Creation of a National Public Procurement Training Program Unit (UPNFMP) under the supervision of the ONMP / Advisory Committee

Systematization of the training management process in public organizations: from the collection of training needs to the evaluation of completed activities

Design of training programs and skills' development activities corresponding to the different clienteles identified

Components

Elaboration of norms for the educational material used with the aim of standardization

Development of adapted educational formulas to ensure national coverage at the lowest cost: e-learning

Establishment and implementation of an accreditation and certification system for institutions and target groups

Development of an information system that will provide maximum information for decision makers



Training of trainers in public procurement. The objective was to train a national corps of operational trainers who would provide all public purchasers with appropriate training


















Opening of HAICOP to its External Environment

- Organization of a series of conferences, which will deal with all the aspects of current regulation and planned reforms as to stimulate the participation of SMEs in public procurement in Tunisia.








3rd Edition of the Public Procurement Show


