### 4. E-GP

Burkina Faso launched on March 21, 2022 a tender for the acquisition of an e-GP solution comprising, inter alia, the following requirements:

- The e-GP system must be able to adapt to the changes brought in to the OCDS scheme and the future OCDS versions during the whole lifetime of the e-GP system use
- The Open Contracting Data Portal must have open data structured on every contracting process from the procurement plan to contract management (in accordance with the latest OCDS versions)
