

The International Master in Public Procurement Management is a full-time, one-year, advanced programme, with an interdisciplinary content focused on managerial, economic, juridical, ethical and IT procurement issues and is designed for procurement specialists interested in professional upgrading and advancement. We are now delivering the 10th generation of the Program and are ready to launch the 11th Edition.

The Master structure includes:

- Online access to a detailed reference list reviewing the fundamental concepts on the core subjects of the course in February;
- 13 Modules delivered in four months with daily in-class lectures with mandatory attendance and two exam periods;
- Three-month internship (to be held within participants' company);
- Final distance learning module on Procurement in Fragile Contexts delivered on Zoom in Autumn.



Applications from qualified candidates should be done only electronically on the Master website using the <u>Apply Now</u> button. Applications are open until the class is full, but due to the limited number of seats available, candidates are strongly advised to apply as early as possible.

Eligibility criteria

In order to be eligible for the IMPPM programme, applicants must:

- Have either an Italian (2 years) Master of Science University degree (Laurea Magistrale, Laurea Specialistica or Laurea vecchio ordinamento) or an equivalent foreign University degree;
- Have at least five years of prior working experience in procurement.
 Only a limited number of applicants who have recently graduated and who have little professional experience in procurement will be taken into consideration;
- Must be proficient in English. No proficiency exams or certificates will be required. English knowledge will be evaluated during the admission interviews with candidates.
